# Ultrasound School of North American Rheumatologists

## a 501c3 non-profit organization

USSONAR is a 501c3 non-profit organization whose objective is to train physicians and allied health professionals in ultrasonography for the management of rheumatic diseases.

With more than 750 members, USSONAR has a diverse network of clinicians and researchers involved in academia and private practice, many of whom are known and emerging key opinion leaders in various disease states including rheumatoid arthritis, spondyloarthropathies, crystalline diseases, lupus, Sjögren's syndrome, osteoarthritis, inflammatory myositis, autoimmune interstitial lung disease, and vasculitis. Many participate in the development of local and international standards of patient care, research, and medical education. Many hold leadership positions in regional and international societies, academic divisions, and healthcare administration. We are administered through external support from Suwannee River Area Health Education Center (SRAHEC).

USSONAR is known for its trademark Fundamentals of Musculoskeletal Ultrasound Program, which since 2007 has trained over 700 adult and pediatric fellows, practicing rheumatologists, and Advanced Practice Providers (APPs), including NPs and PAs. The eight-month program in basic musculoskeletal ultrasound uses a hybrid strategy by providing of educational materials and asynchronous reviews of submitted scans through an interactive educational website and a live, in-person course.

In 2017 USSONAR began holding advanced courses covering topics pertinent to the evaluation of rheumatic diseases, such as vasculitides, lupus, rheumatoid arthritis, spondyloarthropathies, Sjögren's syndrome, autoimmune interstitial lung disease, inflammatory myositis, crystalline arthropathies, and the use of relevant procedures such as ultrasound-guided arthrocentesis and synovial biopsies.

## USSONAR Fundamentals of Musculoskeletal Ultrasound: When a Certificate is more than just a piece of paper

Since 2007, it is well recognized among rheumatologists in the United States that a certificate from USSONAR signifies hours of hard work and dedication to advancing the field of rheumatology.

Up to 130 rheumatology fellows apply to our program each year. Due to course limitations only 75 fellows are accepted and graduate from this rigorous eight-month training program.

The program requires learners to:

- Relearn anatomy
- Learn how to use ultrasound with the use of USSONAR scanning guides and modules
- Advance their knowledge and skills towards the evaluation of rheumatic diseases
- Submit at least 50 scans online which are then reviewed by faculty mentors who provide video feedback
- Pass a written exam at the two-month mark
- Attend the in-person hands-on course
- Pass an objective structured clinical exam at the end of the year

A certificate of completion in the program enables learners to sit for the American College of Rheumatology Musculoskeletal Ultrasound Certification Exam (RhMSUS).





The **USSONAR Fundamentals of Musculoskeletal Ultrasound Program** has grown steadily. Currently, there are 58 active faculty mentors. The number of graduates has increased by approximately 5% annually. Notably, one scan can take up to thirty minutes to review and provide proper feedback. As of May 2025, faculty members have provided mentorship on 4,961 scans.

Despite curricular advancements, the majority of rheumatology fellowship programs rely on the USSONAR Program to provide the medical knowledge and skills required for rheumatologic ultrasound. Faculty retention and shortages continue to be persistent challenges for individual fellowship programs. USSONAR offers a steady and reliable framework for integrating ultrasound into fellowship curricula and provides participants with a supportive network to guide their learning.

Ultrasound cannot be mastered through a three-day course alone. It requires revisiting foundational anatomy knowledge from medical school and applying it to the care of patients with rheumatic diseases. The program offers a network of mentors, including faculty outside of participants' home institutions.

As much as we would like to accept all fellow applicants for the full duration of the program, financial and logistical constraints make this impossible. The cost of one fellow's participation is approximately \$8,000, which includes administrative and website expenses. Additional funding is also needed to support faculty development—updating their knowledge and cultivating their teaching skills—as well as to recognize the contributions of our mentor faculty.



Many USSONAR Fellows have gone on to pursue advanced rheumatologic ultrasound applications, including the evaluation of: salivary glands in Sjögren's syndrome, musculoskeletal and lung manifestations of systemic sclerosis and lupus, and large vessels in Takayasu's arteritis and giant cell arteritis. Many have also become faculty mentors themselves, leaders in their divisions, and prominent figures in regional and international societies.

As a result, we are currently seeking supporters for the Fundamentals Program. We hope you will consider supporting our cause and the future of rheumatology.

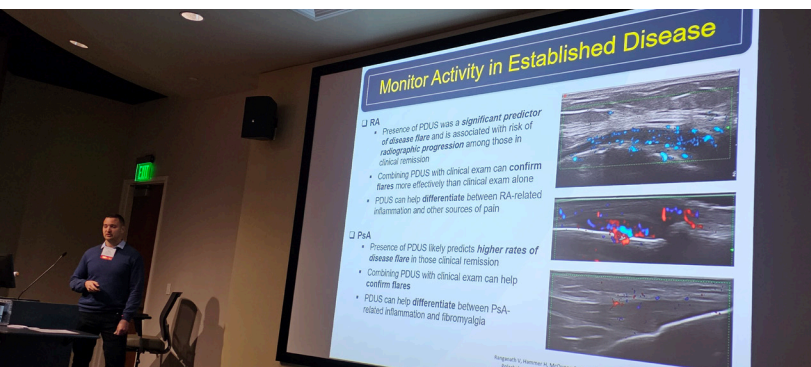

“Participating in the USSONAR program during my first year of Rheumatology fellowship (2022-2023) was the most valuable experience I have had as a trainee. Musculoskeletal ultrasound is becoming an increasingly necessary extension of the rheumatologist’s physical exam to improve early diagnostics and accuracy of joint injections. I was eager to acquire this skill as a fellow, but unfortunately did not have anyone within our institution who could train me. Over an 8-month period, I worked through modules, lectures, reading lectures, and reading assignments in a guided well-paced curriculum. I performed hundreds of ultrasound scans on my own patients in clinic and received personalized feedback weekly from MSUS experts on my image acquisition and interpretation of pathology. Through this program, I was able to interact and learn from dozens of rheumatologists across the country, in a variety of practice settings, and develop a network of mentors.

While remote learning is now commonplace, USSONAR has been a leader in tele-education. In fact, because of my time in the USSONAR program, I was able to coordinate additional learning experiences through the use of teleguidance on our handheld ultrasound device provided by USSONAR. Mentors could adjust my preset, mode, gain, depth, and circle structures on the screen to help me distinguish between soft tissue, joint capsule, and synovium, all in real time. Most importantly, they could not touch my probe and take over the scan, which inevitably happens after a trainee struggles to obtain the image after a period of time.

I am now launching an ultrasound program as a first-year faculty at my institution. I am extremely thankful to have been able to acquire this skill and receive mentorship from rheumatologists across the country. I highly recommend this program to all fellows so that they can acquire US skills that will improve the delivery of care to our patients.”

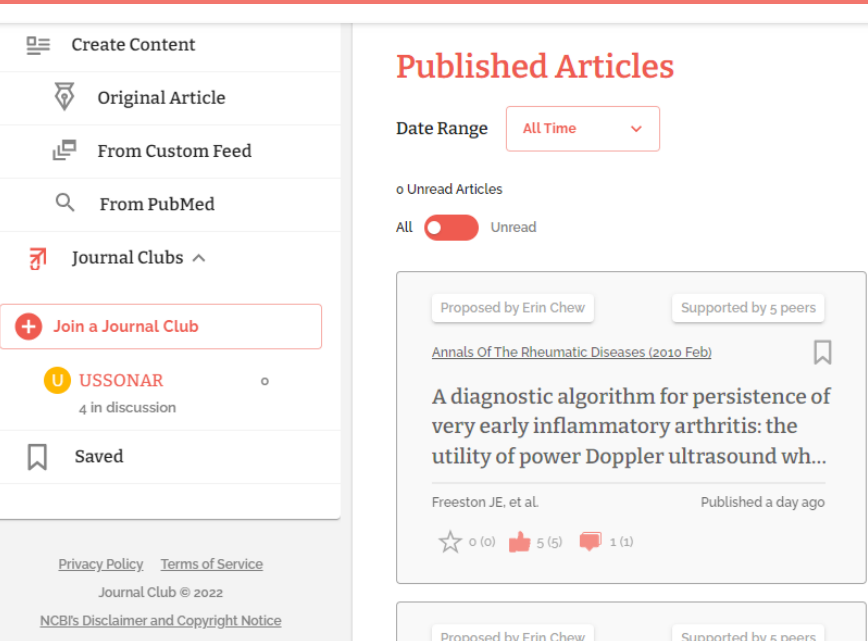
“I went through the USSONAR training program as a fellow from 2009 to 2010, which was its second year of existence. There was no one at my institution who was active in musculoskeletal ultrasound teaching, and it is not a skill I would likely have today had this program not been available to me at that time. I used an old loaner machine and submitted 50 different scans of all major joints commonly examined in Rheumatology, complete with examples of pathology- ranging from synovitis/inflammatory changes, sports injuries, mechanical degradation/osteoarthritis, and even nerve entrapment such as carpal tunnel. The online mentors provided high-level, personalized feedback in real-time (or within a matter of days). The hands-on course, complete with cadaver models for guided injections, as well as the hands-on final exam to complete the program, were pivotal training moments in my career.

I immediately signed on to be a mentor in the first year following my graduation and have continued to be an active member over the past decade-plus. I introduced the musculoskeletal ultrasound curriculum to the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Seattle, Washington, and have continued to utilize this imaging modality daily in my practice. I teach/lecture nationally, not only to rheumatologists, but also to physical medicine physicians, orthopedists, family practice physicians, and even dermatologists who are interested in expanding their use of this modality.

The quality of education and content is unparalleled in the field of rheumatologic ultrasound. I would recommend the USSONAR program to anyone who is interested, and I would like to express my sincerest gratitude to our sponsors for allowing the program to be possible for so many fellows. This training often occurs during a period of our mentees’ careers when extra educational content is not easily affordable.”

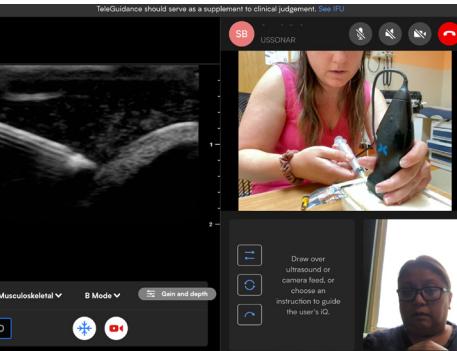
